This is not a typical corridor - in IBC terms a corridor is typically considered an "exit access" and may or may not be protected by fire rated partitions and doors.

Fire-retardant-treated wood enclosed in noncombustible or limited-combustible materials shall be permitted in accordance with NFPA 220. Openings in the separation shall be protected by fire door ...
