

# How to use an electrical port to optical port module

The SFP+ port needs to be used in conjunction with an SFP+ optical module or SFP+ electrical port module to establish a connection and data transmission between devices.

Connecting SFP modules with Ethernet cables is a straightforward process that requires inserting the Ethernet cable into the module and then securing the module in the SFP port.

Match different: the electric port module is usually used with Category 5, Category 6, Super Category 6 or Category 7 cables, while the optical module is usually connected with the optical fiber patch cords.

The SFP port is a built-in optical port of a Gigabit Ethernet switch, so it cannot be directly connected with a twisted pair or a jumper. It needs to be connected to an optical module first, and ...

Hold the plug of the electrical port module until the optical module is completely removed. If the electrical port module cannot be pulled out easily, please check carefully if there are any stuck ...

Align the module with the device's SFP port, ensuring TX/RX labels match the cable's direction. Gently push the module until it clicks into place (a latch will secure it).
