

Intermittent network connectivity at access switch

Try rebooting the switch as a temporary measure to resolve any transient connection issues. Ensure to save or back up any important switch configurations before the restart.

If you're not seeing errors in the log files on any of the switches and the layer three routing doesn't appear to be the culprit, then I would investigate the spanning-tree.
