Since connecting the GEC to the meter box is also in effect bonding ground to neutral and is an NEC recognized place to do this, you would not be allowed to bond the two in the main panel.

However under NEC 2020, there's now a requirement for a fireman's outdoor disconnect, which means, well, the fastest way to bring this into compliance is replace the pre-2020 "meter pan" ...

Meter combos are single enclosures that integrate a utility meter socket and a main breaker that may also include additional branch circuit breaker spaces for power distribution.
