

Shared server rack not connected to network

We have had several times in the past 6-8 months where certain users (does not affect everybody - also does not affect Mac machines) will not be able to access the shared drives (hosted ...

This article is an ultimate comprehensive guide to fix Network sharing not working in Windows 11, including issues related to Network sharing credentials etc.

Enter the network path (for example, PCNameSharedFolder), check the box for Reconnect at sign-in, and click Finish. This should restore access to your shared folders.

The specific steps to take depend on the error that appears in Windows when accessing a shared folder, and on the settings of the remote SMB server that hosts the network shares.

Usually this would happen at one of our remote locations but it is happening at our main building where we never have shared drive issues. Does anyone know how to fix this issue?
