If you're travelling to Palestine, you might be wondering if you can use your electrical appliances there. Different countries have different plug outlets, and there are a surprising number of variations out there.

The standard voltage in Palestine (230 V) is much higher than the voltage level your devices typically operate at in the United States (120 V). Without a converter, you risk serious damage to your devices.

Palestine operates on 230V/50Hz electricity with Type C (European two-pin) and Type H (Israeli three-pin) outlets throughout the territories. US travelers need plug adapters for both outlet ...

No, you will need a voltage converter to safely use your American curling or flat iron in Palestine. The higher voltage (230 V vs. 120 V) can damage the device, and the different frequency ...

You can use all your equipment in Palestine if the outlet voltage in your own country is between 220V-240V. This is the case in most of Europe, Australia, the United Kingdom and most countries in Africa ...
