

What level of beam splitter is the optical cross-section box

Cube beam splitters provide equal optical path lengths for both output beams -- important for interferometry. Plate beam splitters require a compensation plate in one arm to match path lengths.

Particularly in NDIR gas analysis, this design enables measurement with only one beam with a minimal beam cross-section, which significantly increases the interference immunity of the measurement.

A third version of the beam splitter is a dichroic mirrored prism assembly which uses dichroic optical coatings to divide an incoming light beam into a number of spectrally distinct output ...
