A tariff quota allows a limited quantity of specific goods to be imported into the EU at a reduced (partial suspension) or zero (total suspension) rate of the normal duties applicable to imported goods during ...

A quota may require employees to perform tasks at a specified speed, perform a quantified number of tasks, or handle an amount of goods within a defined period.

QUOTA definition: the share or proportional part of a total that is required from, or is due or belongs to, a particular district, state, person, group, etc. See examples of quota used in a sentence.

A quota is a specific proportional share or allotment assigned to a person or group. It can also refer to a quantitative restriction, setting a minimum or maximum number for a particular item or activity.

In a given period (normally one year), a lower in-quota tariff (t) is applied to the first Q units of imports and a higher out-of-quota tariff (T) is applied to all subsequent imports.

Quota definition: A proportional share, as of goods, assigned to a group or to each member of a group; an allotment.
